Budget-2017-18

Dr. Raman Singh, presented a budget estimate of 76,032 crore for the fiscal 2017-18. Welfare of poorest of the poor and inclusive growth; creation of development opportunities through infrastructure building and stregthening of human capital; digital inclusion and good governance are the highlights of the budget.

2. Goods and Services Tax is to be implemented soon. Hence, no major change in the tax structure is proposed.

3. Dr. Singh reaffirmed his commitment to the poor, the farmers, women, youth, the deprived sections of the society by introducing many pro-poor welfare measures.

5. The Estimated Revenue receipt is 66 thousand 94 crore, which includes the central share of centrally sponsored schemes i.e. 14 thousand 101 crore. With an estimated growth of 6.6 percent in tax revenue and 3.8 percent in non-tax revenue, the total growth in state's own revenue is 6 percent.

6. The estimated expenditure is 7.58 percent higher than the revised estimate of 2016-17.

7. Revenue surplus is estimated at 4 thousand 781 crore.

8. Gross fiscal deficit is estimated at 9 thousand 647 crore, which is 3.49 percent of GSDP.

9. Due to plan and non-plan merger in central budget, the budget estimate of 2017-18 is classified as revenue expenditure and capital expenditure only.

10. Total revenue expenditure estimated is 61 thousand 313 crore and total capital expenditure is 14 thousand 454 crore. Capital expenditure is 19 percent of the total expenditure.

11. The budget allocates 36 percent of expenditure in development heads for Scheduled Tribe sector and 12 percent for the Scheduled Caste sector.

12. The Social sector expenditure is estimated at 41 percent and Economic sector expenditure is 38 percent of the total expenditure.

Tax Proposals

Consumers will get half a percent tax relief in case of payment through digital mode except for specified articles like cement, steel, coal, diesel, petrol, kerosene, motor vehicle, pan masala, tobacco products. This arrangement will operate till the time GST is implemented.
